

AGREEMENT FOR INTERDISTRICT COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR

This Agreement is hereby entered into by and between the Northwest Career & Technical Academy, Mount Vernon School District No. 320, Skagit County, Washington, which is hereinafter referred to as the "Serving District," and

Stanwood-Camano SD No. 401, Skagit County, Washington, hereinafter referred to as the "Participating District."

The purpose of this Agreement is to utilize interdistrict cooperation, authorized by RCW 28A.355.160, RCW 28A.225.250, and Chapter 392-135 WAC, to provide educational programs not otherwise available and to avoid duplications of specialized programs and facilities. These objectives will be achieved by attendance at the Northwest Career & Technical Academy programs including the following:

This agreement gives the Northwest Career & Technical Academy permission to access student records data including address information from the data resource management center of the Participating District, to be used for all necessary Northwest Career & Technical Academy operations.

The Cooperative anticipates implementing all or a portion of this agreement during the **2019-2020** school year. It is understood that students who attend the Participating District and the Serving District shall be funded for all classes up to 1.6 full time equivalents as determined by the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction per SB5790. This agreement is for the **2019-2020** school year, beginning on or before **August 30, 2019 through August 31, 2020**, and was approved by each respective Board of Directors.
