#### SCHOOL BOARD RECOGNITION

During the Superintendent Report portion of the meeting, Dr. Rumbaugh read Gov. Jay Inslee's <u>proclamation</u> marking January 2022 as School Board Recognition Month, recognizing them "as outstanding volunteers and champions for public education." Dr. Rumbaugh thanked the Board for its dedicated service to the students and families of Stanwood-Camano.

#### **EQUITY REPORT**

Maurene Stanton, executive director of Human Resources and Equity, reported on student-Initiated Equity Leadership Teams now organized at all secondary schools with advisors in place.

Lincoln Hill High School teacher David Choe told the Board the Equity Team is student-led and directed. They have created an equity wall, comment box, and organized activities for Black History Month, Martin Luther King Jr. Day and Pride. LHHS has also partnered with the SHS Equity Team. "The club has taken root at Lincoln and the students are taking a lot of pride in it," Choe said.

The district has engaged PUSH Inspiration to assist with equity professional development for staff during four presentations this school year.
