STRATEGIC PLAN UPDATE

During the Superintendent Report portion of the meeting, Mutiu Fagbayi of Performance Fact gave an update on the strategic planning process now underway in the district. The Strategic Plan serves as a roadmap for our school system. Its primary aim is to align our community on a shared vision, common goals, and unified direction for our district's educational efforts. Five planning teams have been meeting regularly, and students, staff, families, and community members have been surveyed. Two community forums will be held on February 8 (focus on elementary) and February 10 (focus on secondary).

ALTERNATIVE LEARNING EXPERIENCE (ALE) ANNUAL REPORT

Ryan Pike, principal of Lincoln Hill High School, Lincoln Academy, and Saratoga School presented the annual ALE <u>report</u>. The Church Creek campus houses the three programs. Saratoga School, the district's parent partnership program, has eight teachers serving 263 students during the 2021-22 school year. Pike described the written student learning plans at each school to guide instruction and learning. Alternative learning programs support overall goals for academic achievement.

FOOD SERVICE UPDATE

Food Services director Don Vennetti <u>reported</u> on the challenges the department has had this year with staffing due to COVID and the limited availability of substitutes. Supply chain issues have persisted, affecting paper supplies for serving and food items for the menus. He reported that the district has been shorted items on every order placed. This causes substitutions to the menu.

Stanwood-Camano School District is currently developing a five-year Strategic Plan for our schools.


