Julie Echols, Principal of Utsalady Elementary, presented the school <u>report</u>. She gave an overview of enrollment by student demographic and how student learning has grown over time.

A highlight from this year has been Utsalady's recognition as a Special Olympics Unified Champion School, which recognizes whole school engagement in creating an inclusive environment, student leadership, and creating a Unified Sports program.

School goals for 2021-2022 have included:

- To create a safe learning environment postpandemic
- Focused time for responsive classroom practices, morning meetings, Character Strong lessons, and school counselor interventions, with ongoing support from teachers, partnerships with families
- To improve student achievement and engagement in writing
- Focused professional development on writing using standards, enduring concepts, student work samples, and writing continuums.

Planned 2022-2023 Inclusionary Practices and Tiered interventions:

- To create an inclusive environment
- Regular meetings with teachers and support staff to progress and monitor achievement
- In-classroom support for all students
- Partnerships with families to support all students

## **EQUITY UPDATE**
