**DONATIONS**

1. Nancy Cooper donated framed prints and assorted children's books, value \$185.00, to the Stanwood-Camano School District for Twin City Elementary.
2. Linda Thayer donated a Gemeinhardt Flute and a Bach Trumpet, valued at \$400.00, to Stanwood Middle School Band.
3. The Stanwood-Camano School District received transportation costs:
  - a. \$122.60 from the Washington Association of Maintenance and Operations Administrators (WAMOA) for the Stanwood Middle School choir's performance at the WAMOA luncheon in December.
  - b. \$262.66 and \$509.78 from the Stanwood High School Booster Club – Sports Account for the high school wrestling team's travel to a tournament in Bremerton, the soccer team trip to Warm Beach Camp and the track team's trip to Seattle.
