CAPITAL PROJECTS MONTHLY REPORT

Overall Fund Update:

- No new change orders have been issued since the October 2017 report.

Bond Projects Update:

The New Stanwood High School (SHS):

- Chris Lilley, with McGranahan Architects, will provide a report on the schematic design progress for all three projects. The board will consider a recommendation on the consent agenda for approval of this design phase and authorize moving into design development.
- Following board approval to begin design development, the architect will provide a report on the value engineering (VE) study results and will identify the VE recommendations that were implemented and reasons for rejecting other VE ideas.
- The project schedule calls for bidding the site improvement work this spring. The bid specifications are now being developed to meet that timeline.

Alternative Learning Center (ALC):

- No changes other than as reported in the schematic design phase presentation tonight.

Facility and Technology Maintenance Building (MTC):

- No changes other than as reported in the schematic design phase presentation tonight.

Facilities and Technology Levy Update:

- We have reissued the call for bids for the Twin City Elementary sidewalk addition. Bids are due on November 7, at 1:00pm. As you may recall, this project was put out to bid last summer and no bids were submitted.
- We are in the process of reviewing the list of levy funded facility projects to be completed in the summer of 2018. The recommended projects should be ready for presentation to the board in November.
- The Tech Department has been busy installing teacher presentation systems in the schools.
