Board policy 6881 requires school board approval when disposing of equipment when there are multiple items having a total unit value in excess of \$10,000.

The district has 11 portable classroom units located at Stanwood High School that need to be removed prior to beginning construction of the new school. The district does not have a use for these units and they are currently vacant. It is difficult to determine a value for these classrooms since they are in need of various repairs and will have to be relocated.

These items will be placed for sale on the state surplus property website and will be advertised to school districts and other local governmental agencies in our region. Any unsold units may be made available to private parties or they may be demolished on site and removed. Proceeds from the sale of such equipment will be deposited in either the district's General Fund or Capital Projects Fund.

Recommendation:

We recommend the board *move to approve the disposal of surplus portable classroom units located at Stanwood High School.*
