#### **2020-21 School Year**

OSPI released its [guidance](#) for reopening schools yesterday. OSPI was clear that students will be provided with some face-to-face instruction during the 2020-21 school year as long as the DOH guidelines can be adhered to. There are three highlighted models on page 30 of the guidelines. They are 1) Split or rotating schedules with continuous remote learning; 2) Phased-in opening with continuous remote learning; 3) Continuous Learning 2.0 (all distance learning) The district will be exploring these three models and will survey families within the next week to receive input.

#### **Chromebooks**

Students who are returning to the SCSD in the fall may keep their chromebooks to access available educational resources during the summer. Students not returning to school due to graduation or other reasons will be provided with instructions from their schools regarding returning their chromebooks.

##### **Summer Feeding Program**

**From July 1- August 30** the District will be providing meals on Tuesdays and Thursdays. On Tuesday, 3 days of meals will be provided. On Thursdays, 4 days of meals will be provided. Food distribution will be held from 10:00-1:00 at the following locations:  
Stanwood Middle School, Twin City Elementary School, Elger Bay Elementary School and Cedarhome Elementary School.

## P-EBT (Pandemic EBT) Cards

“Due to the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), children who are eligible for free or reduced-price meals at school will get extra food benefits. These food benefits are called Pandemic EBT (P-EBT). P-EBT benefits help families in Washington buy food when school is closed.”

How do households qualify for P-EBT benefits?

1. If you receive Basic Food you will automatically receive P-EBT benefits on your existing EBT card. If you qualify for free & reduced-price meals for any other reason **you must apply** for P-EBT.
2. Students not already approved to receive free or reduced-price school meals may complete a meal application any time up to and including June 30th and be eligible for P-EBT benefits. **Applications are available online via Skyward Family Access or beginning June 15th at one of our 16 Grab & Go Meal locations.**
