DONATIONS

(The Board wishes to announce donations publicly. However, in accordance with Board Policy 6114, donations exceeding \$500.00 must formally be approved in the Consent Agenda.)

1. Museum of NW Art (MoNA) provided transportation costs, \$112.48, for Twin City Elementary 1st and 4th grade class to attend and tour the "Visual Thinking Skills Through Art" at the Museum of NW Art in La Conner, Washington.
2. Northwest Farm Credit Services donated the cost of transportation, \$105.16, for the Stanwood Elementary 5th grade field trip to Visser Dairy in Stanwood for science studies.
3. Imagine Children's Museum provided transportation costs, \$207.39, for Twin City Elementary 2nd grade class to attend the Science Exploration Event at Imagine Children's Museum.
4. Elger Bay Elementary PTA provided transportation costs, \$519.70, for Elger Bay Elementary field trips for 4th grade to the corn maze in Snohomish and kindergarten students to the pumpkin patch in Arlington.
