SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

DONATIONS

(The Board wishes to announce donations publicly. However, in accordance with Board Policy 6114, donations exceeding \$500.00 must formally be approved in the Consent Agenda.)

1. Wesley Garman and Collin McMillan donated \$200 to the Stanwood High School band program.
2. Stanwood Elementary PTO provided transportation costs to Stanwood Elementary for the kindergarten field trip to the Children's Museum (\$402), a 4th grade field trip (\$369.19), and the 5th grade literacy study field trip to the Everett Performing Art Center.
3. Twin City Elementary PTA provided transportation costs, \$270.79, to Twin City Elementary for the kindergarten field trip to the Everett Children's Museum and for the Highly Capable field trip to Camp Casey.
4. Utsalady Booster Club donated \$257.17 and \$436.95 to Utsalady Elementary to purchase playground rubber balls and a button-maker.
5. Box Tops for Education Program donated \$283.10 to Utsalady Elementary.
6. Stanwood Booster Club, Sports Account, provided transportation costs, \$486.79, to Stanwood High School athletics program for the track team's competition in Seattle and the boys soccer team camp at Warm Beach.
7. Stanwood Band Boosters donated \$2,640 and \$13,065 to the Stanwood High School band program to purchase audiovisual equipment and band equipment.

1. Stanwood High School hosted a successful blood drive on May 3. Gayle Richards, Bloodworks Northwest Representative, recognized Christine Del Pozo, Principal, George Colby, Leadership Advisor, and Jill Knott, school nurse, for their support.
