DONATIONS

(The Board wishes to announce donations publicly. However, in accordance with Board Policy 6114, donations exceeding \$500.00 must formally be approved in the Consent Agenda.)

1. Sharon Hanson donated a metal filing cabinet, valued at \$391.30, to the Stanwood Middle School band program.
2. The Stanwood-Camano School District received the following donations:
 - a. *Alliance for a Healthier Generation*, \$200 Target eGiftcard to the food services department to create healthier learning environments for students,
 - b. *Cedarhome Elementary PTO*, \$300 for a Cedarhome Elementary STEM Club teacher stipend and \$2,921.25 for three teacher stipends for outdoor education.
