Attached are the schedules for meal prices and for fees proposed by the school principals for fiscal year 2018-19.

The full price lunch fee was increased by 25 cents at the June 5, 2018 School Board meeting.

Stanwood High School increased the fee for the Art I from \$10 to \$15 and the Agriculture fee from \$20 to \$25 to cover cost increases. Port Susan Middle School increased the Family and Consumer Science fee from \$5-\$15 to \$10-\$20 and Technology Education from \$10 to \$10-\$20 due to increased costs.

The Pre-School program at Stanwood Elementary is increasing from \$100 to \$125.

Board Policy 3520 requires an annual fee report be submitted to the board for the coming year. The policy does not require board approval of student fees, just a report.

Recommendation:

We recommend the board **move to accept the student fee schedule and food service price schedule report as attached for FY 2018-19.**

SUBJECT: Pre-school peer role model program fees  
DATE: August 7, 2018

The Pre-School program is requesting a fee adjustment for our peer role-model program at Stanwood Elementary from \$100 to \$125.

In researching other programs in the area we have found:

Our Saviors Lutheran costs \$234 per month 4 days per week  
Camano Lutheran costs \$240 per month 4 days per week  
The Little Red Schoolhouse costs \$250 3 days per week, and  
Stanwood Co-op costs \$150 3 days per week, parent has to work 1 day per week in the classroom

Our program is four days per week for comparable time to the above listed programs.

Recommendation: It is recommended the board approve the fee request.
