Family Communication February 8, 2021

Thank you to all of our families who have completed the “return to school” survey. We have received responses from almost 50% of our families. If you have not yet completed the survey, please do so using this [LINK](#) (English) [ENLACE-ESPAÑOL](#)

Based upon the survey results all middle school students are invited to attend school in a hybrid format beginning on February 22. Students with last names beginning with letters A-K will attend on Mondays and Tuesdays. Students with last names beginning with letters L-Z will attend on Thursdays and Fridays. Students needing to change their assigned days should contact the school office. Resource room students will continue to attend on Wednesdays.

High school students may return in a hybrid format if the case rate remains below 200 per 100,000 per two week period. The case rate is currently at 184 cases per 100,000 per two week period.

The timeline for the return of high school in an in-person format is below:

- February 22: SHS/LHHS: Special populations, some students with multiple failing grades. Schools will notify eligible students.
- March 8: AA/BB Hybrid Model All students eligible for in-person hybrid.
