

2020-2021 Stanwood-Camano Graduation Waiver Information

Due to the pandemic and unprecedented times, all school districts in Washington State were able to apply for graduation credit requirement waivers this year. The Stanwood-Camano School District applied to the State School Board of Education on April 8, 2021. The graduation waiver request was approved on April 12, 2021.

Students will be working with their high school counselors, teachers and administrators to ensure graduation and how waivers might apply. If a student's waiver is denied, the student may appeal to the Assistant Superintendent of Teaching and Learning Lloy Schaaf (lschaaf@stanwood.wednet.edu) within five days of waiver denial.

The request to appeal needs to indicate the reason(s) the specific credit should be waived. Appeals will be heard by staff including a teacher, a counselor and the Assistant Superintendent of Teaching and Learning (or designee).
