Secondary School Reopening Plan

We have finalized the details of the new plan for our secondary school students. Secondary students and their families will receive a survey tomorrow, April 1, which will outline the details. Students will attend 6 periods per day in an AA/BB hybrid model. This survey will come from their student(s) school so that families can indicate if they plan to attend in person or online and if they need transportation.

We need all families to complete a survey for each middle school and high school student who is enrolled in our district. Surveys will be distributed by building principals. Families need to respond to the survey by April 11.

Pandemic EBT

Get money for meals missed by students at school this school year.

Did your child go to a K-12 school this school year that closed or had reduced hours due to the pandemic? Is your child eligible for free or reduced-price school meals? Then your child may be eligible for P-EBT this school year. P-EBT is money that can be used to buy food for your children.
