

Dear Families,

As you know the Stanwood-Camano School District has been working diligently to bring students back to in-person school. As of right now all of our K-5 students who have opted to return are attending school in person in a hybrid model. We are now working on bringing our secondary students back to school. Below you will find a description of the in-person support and safety protocols. Once you have had a chance to review this information, please complete the attached [survey](#) so that we can best plan for the in-person return.

Although we have attempted to outline the plan in detail below, we anticipate that you will have important questions for us. In order to address your questions, we have scheduled a [Zoom](#) meeting for parents on Thursday, February 4th at 6:00 p.m. In preparation for this meeting, please send your questions ahead of time on the attached [google form](#). Our return target date for Middle School students is February 22nd. Depending on survey results, we may return all middle school students on February 22nd or we may phase some in on the 22nd and then the rest a week later on March 1st. More information will follow.

Special populations of students at both Stanwood High School and Lincoln Hill High School are also tentatively scheduled to return on the 22nd of February. You will be notified if your student is part of that group. We will continue to watch COVID Metrics and health department guidelines in order to plan a return for the rest of our high school students.

Overview:

Our school district has worked with our county health department, school administration, and employment unions to develop a model that will allow our secondary students to begin safely returning to the classroom.

All students will continue to receive the same model of instruction that they have received since September. This includes the same assignment release and due date schedule and virtual class meetings throughout each week (slightly adjusted times). In addition to the distance learning model, students will now have the opportunity to attend school for in person support. Please review the details below, which include the specific schedule and details about safety protocols, food services, transportation, and the academic support model. Once you have read through the model and determined what would work best for your student, please take the attached [survey](#) to let us know if your student is planning to attend in person opportunities and if they will need transportation.

Academic Support Model:

Students will attend in person support classes(optional) from 7:40-9:25 and will participate in Google Meets from 11:45-2:10. Direct instruction will continue to take place during Google Meets and academic support will be provided during the in person student time.

This model allows students to remain in their current schedule whether or not they choose to be in person. This is an important factor for our students as we do not want to have major disruption to their individual schedules and assigned teachers. Additionally, it will allow us to maintain continuity in our courses if we are faced with having to pull back on in person opportunities due to COVID related issues.

Schedule:

Students will be assigned to either group A (Last names A through K) or group B (Last names M through Z). Students in group A will have the opportunity to attend in person on Mondays and Tuesdays and group B on Thursdays and Fridays. Requests to shift from the assigned group may be made to the school office and will be handled on a space available basis.

Students who choose to attend in person will attend periods 1 and 2 in week one, periods 3 and 4 in week two, and periods 5 and 6 in week three. The schedule will then repeat.

All students will continue attending virtual classes each week just as they have been all year. Times for these meetings have been modified slightly as reflected in the schedule below.

Safety Protocols and Expectations for Students:

In order to bring students and staff back to in person learning the following protocols and expectations will be followed:

- Students entering a district building will attest to their health, answering questions put forward by our health department. If they answer yes to any health related question they are not to enter.
- In order to attend school, students will be screened, which includes having a temperature less than 100.4 and attesting to not having specific symptoms including: new cough, onset of shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, new muscle aches, headache, fatigue, diarrhea, nausea or vomiting, sore throat and or new loss of taste or smell.
- Symptomatic students should not attend school and must remain home for 10 days or have a negative COVID-19 test in order to return to school.
- Students who have been exposed to COVID-19 must quarantine according to Snohomish County protocol.
- Parents and outside persons will not be allowed to enter the school facility without an exceptional circumstance approved by the building principal.
- Students will be expected to properly wear a cloth or blue paper mask when in district buildings or vehicles (covering both their mouth and nose). (Exceptions may be made for alternate personal protective equipment (PPE) in very specific situations)
- Hand sanitizing stations have been set up around school buildings and students will have access.
- Six foot distancing is the expectation for all students from one another and their teachers..

- Frequent cleaning of high-touch surfaces and disinfection during the school day will occur.
- Occupancy maximums placed outside each room must be strictly adhered to.
- Students will be asked to use restrooms by leaving class one student at a time. We will ask students to avoid using restrooms during class transition times in order to avoid crowded restrooms.

Transportation:

Bus transportation will be provided for students according to typical district procedures. However, safety protocols will be in place including: reduced number of riders, increased cleaning and disinfection, open windows, and boarding and unboarding protocols.

Food Services:

- Students will be allowed to eat snacks and drink water prior to entering the school building. Students will be permitted to drink water during class time by stepping into the hall with their water bottle with teacher permission.
- Meals will not be provided during the day as students will be in academic support from 7:40-9:25, however, families may pre-order 7 day grab and go meals by accessing the link below: You may order 5-day meal bags for your students in Elementary School if they are eating breakfast and lunch in school for the two days they attend.
