TWO LOCATIONS

Beginning the 2023-2024 school year, the Open Doors Program will be available through Skagit Valley College and Everett College. Stanwood-Camano School District will not host an Open Doors program in the district this year.



ELIGIBILITY

Open Doors Youth Re-engagement provides education and services to older youth — ages 16-21 — who have dropped out of school or are not expected to graduate from high school by the age of 21.

Open Doors strives to re-engage disconnected youth through programs that encourage community partnerships, create multiple pathways for students to realize success, and provide an on-ramp to post-secondary achievement through a performance-based, individualized support model.



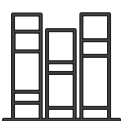
FLEXIBILITY
