The 2020 census prompted a redistricting analysis of board member districts. The redistricting process requires a public hearing, resolution adoption, and submission to the counties and Educational Service District (ESD). Maps have been available at the district office and on the district website for public viewing since February 21, and a public hearing was conducted at the March 7, 2023, regular board meeting. There were no comments.

I recommend adoption of the director redistricting plan and corresponding Resolution No. 2022/2023-004.

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2022/2023-004**

**WHEREAS** the Stanwood-Camano School District No. 401 has received the 2020 federal decennial census information applicable to the Stanwood-Camano School District; and

**WHEREAS** the Stanwood-Camano School District No. 401 is a special purpose district with a governing body comprised by internal director districts delineated in chapter 29A.76.010 of the Revised Code of Washington and is obligated to respond accordingly to receipt of census data; and

**WHEREAS** the Stanwood-Camano School District No. 401 has conducted a review of these census data relative to the criteria established by Chapters 28A.343.040 and 29A.76.010(4) of the Revised Code of Washington resulting in the development of modifications to its director districts; and

**WHEREAS** a public hearing was advertised in The Everett Herald and Stanwood-Camano News and held on March 7, 2023, for the purpose of presenting the proposed Stanwood-Camano School District No. 401 director district revisions and to receive related public comments; and

**WHEREAS** after hearing and considering public comment relative to the proposed director district revisions for more than one week, pursuant to Chapter 29A.76.010(5) of the revised Code of Washington the Stanwood-Camano School District No. 401 Board of Directors has determined that director district revisions are necessary to provide for constituent needs and to comply with statutory requirements.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Stanwood-Camano School District No. 401 Board of Directors hereby adopts the director district revisions presented and directs the Superintendent, as Board Secretary, to so notify the Educational Service District and appropriate Snohomish and Island County officials.
