SUBJECT: Policy 3131 District Attendance Area Transfers

DATE: March 7, 2023

TYPE: Action Required

Attached is revised policy 3131 District Attendance Area Transfers. Policy 3131 supports District Attendance Area Transfers and was last revised in 2016. The revisions to this policy supports the work of the Capital Facilities Advisory Committee (CFAC) and aligns with neighboring districts.

**Recommendation:** That the board approves the second reading of policy 3131 District Attendance Area Transfers.

## DISTRICT ATTENDANCE AREA TRANSFERS

Each student in the district is required to attend the school designated for the geographic attendance area in which he or she resides unless the student has been accepted for enrollment in one of the district's schools or special programs designated by the superintendent. These schools with special programs are open to district students without regard to where in the district the student resides.

School attendance boundaries may be changed in order to operate an effective and efficient educational program in those cases where estimated enrollments are in excess or on a trajectory to be in excess of a building capacity.

A parent or guardian may request that his or her child be allowed to attend another school in the district. Requests must be submitted, in writing, to the Assistant Superintendent of Teaching and Learning.

## Transfers may be granted if:

- A. A financial, educational, safety, or health condition affecting the student would be reasonably improved as a result of the transfer;
- B. Attendance at another school in the district is more accessible to the parent's place of work or to the location of child care; or
- C. There is some other special hardship or detrimental condition affecting the student or the student's immediate family, which would be alleviated as a result of the transfer. If the request for transfer is approved, the parent/guardian must assume responsibility for adequate transportation and supervision to and from school. If the request for transfer is denied, the parent or guardian may appeal to the Superintendent designee for review of the decision. Children of full-time certificated and classified school employees may enroll at either the school to which the employee is assigned, or a school within the district's K through 12 continuums, which includes the school to which the employee is assigned.

The Superintendent is authorized to develop and adopt procedures consistent with this policy.
