The Washington State School Directors Association (WSSDA) has recommended updates to policy 5642, Administrative Internships. Policy 5642 was brought before the board for a first reading on January 16th. The Board moved revised policy 5642 forward for a second reading.

Recommendation: We recommend the board approve the second reading of revised policy 5642 on Administrative Internships.

ADMINISTRATIVE INTERNSHIPS

The board recognizes the need to provide training opportunities for prospective administrators. Internships for those who are in the process of acquiring administrative credentials <u>will shall</u> be approved on an individual basis. Specific factors to be used in considering an individual for an internship position <u>will shall</u> include but not be limited to: academic record, teaching ability, leadership qualities, communication skills and dedication to past and present assignments.

If recommended by the screening committee, the superintendent <u>will shall</u> be responsible for scheduling any necessary release time, arranging for constructive supervision of the internship experience and identifying a variety of experiences which will meet the needs of the intern.
