

SHS Dual Credit

What is **dual credit**? From the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), “Dual Credit provides students with the potential to earn high school and college credit at the same time through successful completion of a course and/or corresponding exam. Exam-based options include **Advanced Placement (AP)**. Course-based dual credit options include **Career and Technical Education (CTE) Dual Credit**, **College in the High School (CiHS)**, and **Running Start** programs. Eligibility requirements and availability of each program varies, and distinct enrollment processes and transcription steps may be required for exam scores or course completion to result in college credit. Why dual credit? In today's world, two-thirds of all jobs require some post-high school training or education. Taking dual credit is connected to higher high school graduation rates, college enrollment, and degree completion.”

Running Start – students would attend classes at the community college. Grades and credits would be transcribed on their SHS transcript.
